Our annual Thanksgiving Basket project is under way! Last year St. Fabian school and parish families worked together to provide 137 Thanksgiving dinner baskets to three Detroit area Catholic schools, as well as C.A.R.E.S Food Bank in Farmington and St. Dominic Outreach Center in Detroit. Our goal this year is to put together 140 baskets. In these troubling economic times, we appreciate whatever you can do to help those less fortunate.

One phase of our project is a drive to raise money to purchase needed items for the baskets. The next part of the project is the non-perishable food drive. We are collecting the following items: **Cans of yams** (40 oz), **carrots, green beans, corn, peas** (all 14.7 oz), **cranberry sauce** (14 oz), **turkey gravy** (<u>CANS</u> <u>ONLY, NO GLASS JARS, PLEASE</u>) and boxes of **corn muffin mix** (8 oz), **stuffing** (6 oz), and **mashed potatoes** (13.7 oz). Please see the back side of this flyer for what each grade is asked to bring. There will be collection boxes in each classroom. <u>Please have all non-perishable donations here by Wednesday, November 17<sup>th</sup>.</u>

The last phase includes assembling and delivery. Our Youth Group will assemble the baskets on Sunday, November 21<sup>st</sup>. **Delivery will be on Tuesday, November 23<sup>rd</sup>**. Preschool (3's)	2 cans of peas (14.7 oz) and 1 box of corn muffin mix (8 oz)
Preschool (4's)	3 boxes of mashed potatoes (13.7 oz)
Kindergarten	2 boxes of mashed potatoes (13.7 oz)
Grade 1	6 boxes of corn muffin mix (8 oz)
Grade 2	4 boxes of stuffing (6 oz)
Grade 3	4 boxes of stuffing (6 oz)
Grade 4	3 cans of peas (14.7 oz)
Grade 5	6 cans of carrots (14.7 oz)
Grade 6	4 cans of corn (14.7 oz) and 4 cans of green beans (14.7 oz)
Grade 7	5 cans of yams (40 oz)
Grade 8	4 cans of turkey gravy (cans only—NO GLASS JARS) and 4 cans of cranberry sauce (14 oz)
